

Snow day number work

Please have a go at carrying out these calculations. The second row are always more tricky. Stop when it gets a bit too difficult.

ADDITION - Put the BIG number in your head and count on.

$3 + 5 =$

$2 + 6 =$

$2 + 5 =$

$3 + 8 =$

$4 + 9 =$

$5 + 10 =$

$13 + 4 =$

$2 + 14 =$

MISSING NUMBERS - Start with the first number in your head then count on to see how many more you would need to reach the total.

$\underline{\quad} + 3 = 6$

$4 + \underline{\quad} = 6$

$6 + \underline{\quad} = 9$

$\underline{\quad} + 7 = 10$

$5 + \underline{\quad} = 10$

$8 + \underline{\quad} = 12$

$\underline{\quad} + 10 = 16$

$\underline{\quad} + 15 = 20$

SUBTRACTION - Start with the first number in your head and then count BACK to find the total.

$5 - 2 =$

$7 - 4 =$

$8 - 8 =$

$9 - 6 =$

$10 - 6 =$

$9 - 0 =$

$15 - 3 =$

$17 - 6 =$
