

Snowy Weather work.

Below is some work for you to do with your child in the event of the school having to close due to snow.

This includes a phonics game, some work on patterns and an investigation. The purpose of this is to help your child to continue with their school work and maintain the skills we have been working on in class. It is not essential for you do all or even any of these tasks.

It would also help your child to continue to read for a few minutes every day using either their school reading book or books available at home. If the book at home is too advanced you could read to them and ask your child to read simple words or words they recognise.

Instructions for playing the Reading Game

A dice is needed to play the games. It is better to restrict the numbers to 1, 2 and 3. Cover numbers 4, 5 and 6 with sticky paper and write 1, 2 and 3 on them. Counters are also needed, one for each player.

Put the counters on the 'Start'. Each player takes it in turn to throw the dice and move along. If you land on a word, you try and read it. If you get it correct you move on one space, and if you cannot read it you go back one space. The first person to reach the 'Finish' is the winner. Players do not need to throw an exact number to finish.
